

Conditions of entry the Island territory of Rapa Nui,



Sanitary Resolution number 1057
Health SEREMI, Chile.



Older than 6 years of age:

- Negative PCR 24 hours prior to boarding at a health center authorized by the health authority.
- Mobility pass enabled.
- LATAM document review at the time of the check -Ready to Fly.

Under 6 years old:

- Antigen test or PCR 24 hours prior to boarding done in a health center authorized by the Health Authority.
- They do not need a Mobility Pass.
- The same protocols apply for passengers in transit

Passenger with persistent positive result:

- Attach first positive PCR or antigen made in a Health center authorized by the health authority.
- Attach second test in this case only PCR done in a health center authorized by the health authority.
- More than 10 days must have passed between the first and second test and no more than 1 month before the date of boarding.

Arriving in Rapa Nui:

- Review of the documentation by Seremi de Salud. The review by OPIPA will not be on the plane or in person with the passengers.
- Random antigen test will apply.

After arrival:

- Telephone monitoring of passengers for 7 days.
- Possibility of calling a passenger at random to perform antigen test between the first and fifth day.
- Passenger who refuses or checks positive must remain 7 days in quarantine in a place authorized by the sanitary authority.

Close contact:

- Between 2 days before the onset of symptoms and 7 days after they began with symptoms.
- More than 15 minutes face to face with less than 1 meter of distance and without a mask or its correct use.
- More than 2 hours in a closed place without a mask or its right use.
- Share or spend the night with the positive case in the same home or similar except hotels or similar situation.

Narrow cases with asymptomatic person:

- 02 days before taking the PCR and 7 days from taking the PCR.
- Contact with a positive case without protective measures (Mask and eye protection).
- In the case of a close contact who had COVID and does not exceed 60 days, will not be considered close contact.

Passengers arriving on international flights and Cruises:

- Review of the documentation at the port of arrival (the same requirements for domestic flights).
- Antigen test at port of arrival.
